# August 2022 Motorcycle futures market overview

Perhaps the constant problems we all know about over the last two years that have been used as the reason the economy is in the position it is, still haven't disappeared, but fingers have been pointed in one particular direction by some of the political spectrum and is now vacating Downing Street. Some will find this a positive, but some won't, what should be evident is, was the former PM the cause of our domestic woes, or as the rest of the world is in a similar place with the cost of living and inflation, that it's not going away. The whole world is in a similar position at the moment and irrespective of who is running the UK, so the knock-on effect of material shortages and logistic holdups will continue to hinder supply to our industry. For the second month (June) registration figures released by the Motorcycle Industry Association (MCIA) reduced by 15.7% compared to the same month in 2021. Although it does not look that encouraging, a reminder that the buying patterns over the last few years have been out of kilter to the "norm". At the halfway point in the year the overall numbers are still in a positive position of 10.1%. As this is blurb to be read in conjunction with our future prediction product, it is highly likely that use will be predominantly at the larger end of the capacity spectrum, so worth a look at how the current used supply and prices could reflect the future with new registrations the way they are. The rise of smaller capacities over the last couple of years is still showing growth and the highest market share, with over 40% of the year's registrations in the two smaller bands. Compare this years performance by looking at pre-covid figures, as this is where the current crop of three year old machines are coming from. If the learner legal sector was not as robust as it has been, would the numbers for total PTW be in a negative? The answer is probably yes and the table below illustrates where the larger losses are happening.

A point to consider is why is the larger end of the market is suffering, is it the lack of stock, due to parts or money not being spent by retail customers? Over the last decade, or even a bit longer, the exporting of stock into the Euro zone has caused the domestic stock availability to become increasingly difficult to source, which has of course been the cause of the large increases in prices, particularly in more recent years. With this still happening and fewer registrations, subject to the current economic fallout getting sorted out, used motorcycles will be in demand at a time when there is less available stock. Residuals are still expected to remain strong in the long term.
